Anger over bank bonuses call

Banks could face legal action by disgruntled workers if they are denied bonuses, a City lawyer has said. Employment lawyer Ronnie Fox is representing clients at three different banks who maintain they are entitled to payouts despite the recent conditions. His claims came as a Downing Street spokesman said the Prime Minister wants employees at banks that have received state handouts to waive their bonuses.
